



## Inventory

The below items are included in one shipping box

- Polyethylene DogValet container – sand beige or forest green
- Two keys - for locking front access
- Two rolls of litter pick-up bags - 200 count per roll (preinstalled in lid)
- One roll DogiPot liner trash bags - 50 Count
- Hardware – two 2" x 5/16" bolts, washer, and lock washers

The below item come in a separate shipping box

- Galvanized steel telescoping mounting pillar – 2" x 2" x 4'

*Please check the above inventory and call if any parts are missing.*

## Installation

### Day One

1. **Select a good visible spot** in your community or park where you want to install the DogValet. Park entrances are typically good locations as visitors can take a pick-up bag on their way in and deposit the filled bag on their way out.
2. **Dig a hole** 18" deep x 7" around.
3. **Mix concrete and pour into the hole** - mix, according to bag instructions, a 40 lb bag of "ready to use".
4. **Insert the mounting post** - approximately 18" into the hole. The above ground pole height should be 30".
5. **Level the post** in a straight vertical position and **let concrete dry for at least 12 hours**.

### Day Two

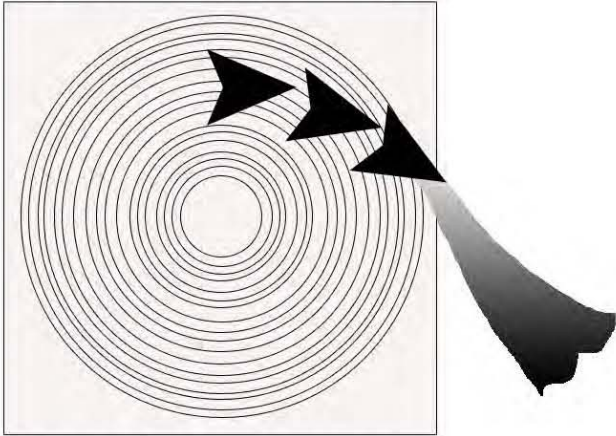
1. **Slide the DogValet's inset back wall completely over the mounting post** so that the exposed post edge is flush with the back of the container. Line up the predrilled holes on the container with those on the post. **Secure** with the two 3" bolts, washer, and locknuts. It may be necessary to wiggle the container slightly up and down on the mounting post to get the bolts through both sets of holes.
2. **Insert a trash liner** bag into the container body folding it over the upper edge of the container.
3. Now sit back and relax while the pet owners pick-up after their dogs!

## Bag Installation

For proper bag dispensing, be sure of the following:

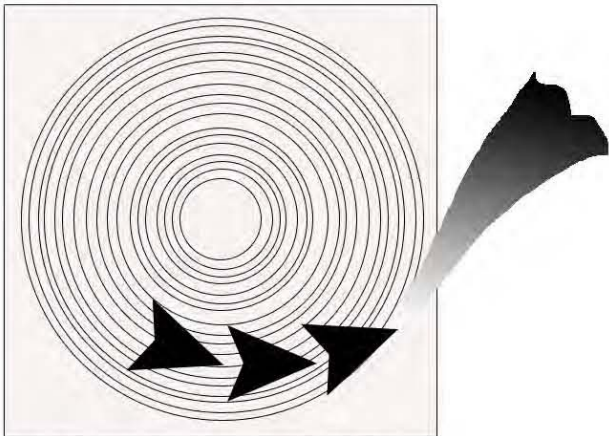
- The dispenser slots match the pick-up bag box slots
- The lettering on the pick-up bag boxes is right-side-up
- The lettering on the pick-up bags is visible on the top when the bags hang out of the slots
- The bags will be dispensed following the upper wall of the dispenser slots - see Illustrations below
